My Happy Mind

We have introduced a programme to all year groups at school called myHappymind. myHappymind helps children to understand how their brain works and to support them in developing positive skills and habits to be their very best selves!

myHappymind is delivered in schools by class teachers through a series of interactive lessons and then the children apply these learnings throughout the day. To further embed this learning and ensure that you are able to engage in these topics with your child, myHappymind has developed a set of resources for parents. These resources can be accessed online on your computer, or through an app on your phone. The resources allow children to continue to practise some of the habits they have developed at school, such as Happy Breathing. Also included are activities for you to do together at home, to complement the in-school lessons.

Pupil Leadership and Pupil Voice in School

This year, we have expanded our student leadership opportunities. In addition to the existing roles of class reps, sports reps, and science ambassadors, we are excited to introduce a new initiative: the Pupil Leadership Council. This council comprises of pupils from Years 4, 5, and 6 who will focus on enhancing teaching and learning, promoting positive behaviour and attitudes, and fostering greater pupil engagement throughout our school community.

End of the day

We ask that children do not play on the play equipment after school as this is not supervised by members of staff. The gates will be locked at 3.20pm so we ask that you make your way to the exit straight after school. If you have an appointment with a teacher that goes beyond 3.20pm, the teacher will escort you to the main door to leave.

Parking

We have been approached by local residents who have said that parents have been parking across driveways and blocking pathways at the beginning and end of the school day. We pride ourselves in working with the whole local community and ask that you are courteous to our residents when dropping off and collecting your child from school.

We would also like to remind you that you should not be parking on zigzag lines outside of school. This restricts people being able to use the road safely to drive and walk. Please Park considerately and help to keep everyone safe.

Building Site

We are aware that lorries have been delivering goods to the building site at the beginning of the school day which, of course, is unacceptable as it is unsafe for our children when crossing the road. Mrs Thomson and Mr Walker met with the building site manager and a

representative of Essex County Council on Thursday to ensure that this will not continue. They have assured us that lorry deliveries will not take place at the beginning or end of the school day.

Medical Appointments

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We appreciate that it is sometimes necessary for medical appointments to be taken during the school day, especially hospital appointments and emergency GP appointments. However we do ask that if your child has a routine optician appointment or routine dental appointment, they are made in out of school hours so that learning is not disrupted.
