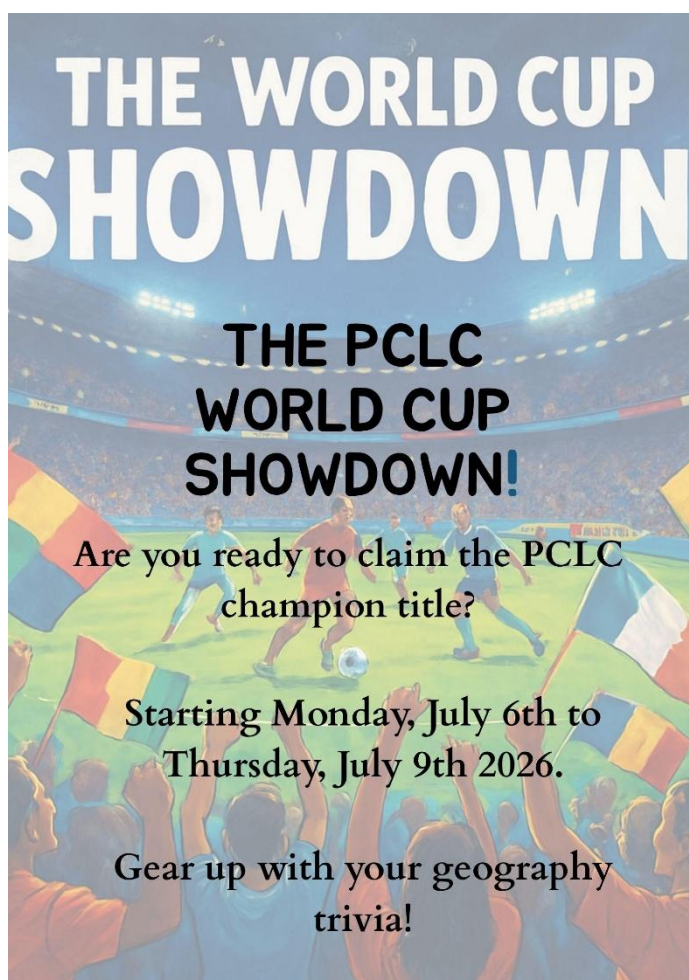
World Cup Competition
